



## Professional Licensure or Certification Disclosure

### Sufficient to Meet Licensure or Certification Requirements:

For those states with legislation and Interior Design Regulatory Boards, passage of the NCIDQ examination is required for registration and certification. In order to sit for this exam, a candidate must provide official education transcripts that include a minimum of 60 semester or 90 quarter credit hours of post-secondary interior design coursework that encompasses a certificate, degree, or diploma from an accredited institution. Samford University's BFA in Interior Design fulfills this requirement.
